Per your request concerning the web design program, have outlined a potential minor (a conservative approach) that, in our opinion, could attract new as well as existing students to the program. I spoke with several Department Chairs who agree with the blending of art and technology courses; and, the interdisciplinary approach could result in many in-field employment opportunities which would substantiate a quality program. Below is a course outline for the proposed minor (i.e., *Web Design for the Entrepreneur*).
